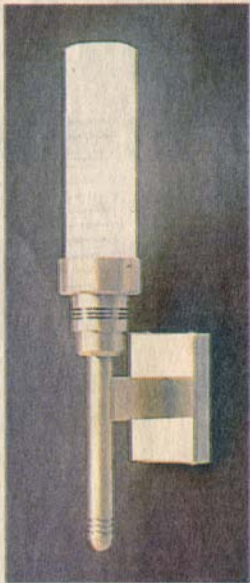


## WALL SCONCES

### Pass The Baton

Benjamin Noriega-Ortiz left Puerto Rico in 1982 to study architecture at Columbia University, was John Saladino's head designer and finally went solo.
